


#### Set the scene

Why are you planting? Who are you aiming at? What is the purpose? What is the need?


## Prayer

Don't assume too much Use a few clear points

Is it following a particular church planting model?

#### Strategy

In a nutshell, how are you going to achieve your vision?

What are the main pillars of your strategy?

How will you measure "success"? How will you know how you're doing?

## Growth plan

How are you going to grow the church?

Are you using Alpha/Christianity Explored/etc?


Are you training leaders?

How will you make new disciples?

#### Preparation Phase

What are you going to do to prepare for the plant?

Who are the stakeholders? Who is your team or helping you?



#### Launch

When are you planting? How are you going to do this? How are you publicising this?

#### Team

Who is on staff, who are the key volunteers, how many on your plant team? What are their roles?

What are the absolute priorities that set the tone and feel of the plant? Are there some quick wins?

## 2 years

What are you prioritising over the first two years?

Don't do too much at once. What are you launching each term?

## 5 years

What are the big picture goals?

What are your mid-term expectations? How many will be coming?

When is your next plant planned for?

## Budget

A simple table of income (where is it coming from) and expenditure (what are the big picture items you are spending on – eg staffing, building fit out, start up items, etc)

It might be helpful to have this over 3 years

# Safeguarding

Outline the steps you are taking to ensure you are providing a safe environment.

#### Stakeholders

Who are you engaging with?

### Next steps

What do you need to do next to help you move forwards?

#### Obstacles

What are the challenges you face and how will you tackle them?

## Help required

What do you need help with?

Are there questions to the panel that you would appreciate input on?

Perhaps show a summary slide or a reminder of the vision.
